



How Do I Enrol?

Penrith Christian School understands that determining the future of your child's education is a very important and significant decision. Enrolment Conditions

- Penrith Christian School is a Preschool to Year 12 School. Preference is given to existing families and families seeking Early Childhood enrolment who are committed to educating their child/children at Penrith Christian Kindergarten to Year 12.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s accept the school's policy that students generally cannot repeat in Preparatory School and declare that the student will progress to Kindergarten at Penrith Christian School. Term's fees are payable for first (1st) term Kindergarten if student is withdrawn prior to commencement of Kindergarten.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s agree to acknowledge that the School's Statement of Faith, which together with the Holy Scriptures, is the foundation document for the beliefs and world view integrated into the curriculum and practices of the school. Parents are asked to sign a statement committing to upholding the Statement of Faith and to continue to exhibit behaviour consistent with the Statement of Faith, as a condition of continued enrolment in the school.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s give consent for their child/children to share fully in the life and program of the school, including the devotional

Penrith Christian School seeks to offer a Christian education to Christian families. In keeping with the school's Enrolment Policy, we do not enrol children from families who are actively practising adherents of religions other than Christianity. Enrolment Application forms are accepted from birth and progress to interview stage one year prior to the year of commencement, dependent upon position availability in the Early Childhood, Junior, Middle and Senior School. An Enrolment Application form is required to be completed for each child*.

- Parent/s or Guardian/s will provide their child/children with the correct uniform approved by the school and ensure they are sent to school each day neatly and appropriately dressed in the required uniform in its entirety and conforming to the School Uniform and Appearance Policy.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s will provide their child/children with all necessary equipment of a personal nature that may be required to enable the child/children to benefit from the education offered.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s accept the responsibility of the school to administer appropriate consequences for disciplinary matters as it deems wise and expedient for the child/children.
- Fees are payable in advance by the fourth (4th) week of each term or alternatively by arrangement with the Principal. In circumstances of financial hardship, alternative arrangements may be discussed with the Principal.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s will give a minimum of one (1) Term's Notice of Termination of Enrolment, Kindergarten to Year 12 and accept

Interviews and first round Offers of Enrolment usually occur during the middle of Term 2. Further Offers of Enrolment may be made up until the time of the student's requested start date, depending on the availability of places.

- Parent/s or Guardian/s will give a minimum of four (4) Term's Notice of Termination of Scholarship Enrolment and accept that failure to do so will render them liable for four (4) term's fees.

- Child/Children will behave in a manner that does not bring dishonour to the name of Christ or disgrace to the school and agree not to use alcohol, tobacco or other illicit substances whilst a student of the school.
- Parent/s or Guardian/s will support the aims of the school and order their own lives and home to enable the child/children to be given every opportunity to grow up into Christ.
